1. Introduction






- APLMF is a group of legal metrology authorities in close cooperation with the APEC.
- ✓ The 23 member economies are located mostly on the Pacific Rim.
- ✓ Established in 1994 in Australia. The president & secretariat were transferred to Japan (2002), PR China (2007), New Zealand (2015), and Malaysia (2021).
- Aims to reduce TBT (Technical Barriers to Trade), exchange information, provide training programs, and cooperate with other international/regional organizations.
- Technical activities and training are conducted by the eight WGs responsible for specific fields in metrology.
- ✓ Forum Meetings were held online from 2020 to 2022 due to the pandemic.
- In November 2023, the 30th Meeting was held in Bohol, the Philippines, where 60 delegates attended.

3a. APLMF Working Groups (WGs)

1. WG on Goods Packed by Measure (WG-GPM) / Dr Rifan ARDIANTO, Indonesia

WG covers prepackages for consumer protection. WG liaises with OIML TC 6 and promotes raising awareness programs.

2. WG on Utility Meters (WG-UM) / Mr WANG Lei, P.R. China

WG covers utility meters for electricity, water, and gas. WG delivered a webinar on EVSE (Electric Vehicle Service Equipment) in September.

3. WG on OIML Certificate Systems (WG-CS) / Ms ZHENG Huaxin, P.R. China

WG liaises with OIML-CS for type evaluation. It provides videos to promote participation in the OIML-CS.

4. WG on Quality Measurement of Agricultural Products (WG-QMAP) / Ms Haslina bte ABDUL KADIR, Malaysia

WG provided a guide document on rice moisture measurement and is developing an e-Learning module. It plans a training course in 2024-2025.

3b. APLMF Working Groups (WGs)

5. WG on Medical Measurements (WG-MM) / Dr DING Xiang, P.R. China

A new WG re-established in 2022. WG delivered a training course in Thailand in July. It liaises with APMP and TC 18 of OIML.

6. WG on Metrological Control Systems (WG-MCS) / Mr GUO Su, P.R. China

WG covers metrology control systems and liaises with OIML.

Sub-Working Group on Digitalization in Metrology (SWG-DM)

/ Dr Muhammad Azwan Bin IBRAHIM, Malaysia

A new SWG liaises with OIML DTG (Digitalization Task Group) and covers the software-controlled measuring instruments.

7. WG on Weighing Instruments (WG-WI) / Ms Suliana GHAZALLI, Malaysia

WG covers NAWIs (Non-automatic Weighing Instruments), AWIs (Automatic Weighing Instruments), and multi-dimensional measuring instruments. It provides an e-Learning module on NAWI.

8. WG on Measurement of Fuels (WG-MF) / Dr Greg HARRINGTON, Australia New WG covers the quantity of fuel. It provides an e-Learning module for fuel dispensers and plans a training course in 2025.











4. APLMF Training Activities

Overview:

- Core activity for strengthening the social infrastructures in legal metrology.
- ✓ Started in 1997 and over 1,500 trainees participated in 75 events.
- ✓ Trainers and materials are provided by a WG and the member economies.
- ✓ Until 2012, an APEC fund was utilized. In 2014, APLMF and APMP participated in the MEDEA (Metrology: Enabling Developing Economies in Asia) project of PTB, Germany.

Current situation:

- ✓ After the pandemic, training has shifted to an **online scheme**.
- ✓ The members use two e-Learning modules on NAWIs and fuel dispensers.
- There are regional concerns on DX in metrology, software, e-Learning, AWIs, CTT (conformity to type), and participation in the OIML-CS. A new survey on prepackages of frozen foods is in progress.
- ✓ Small WG on **Digitalization** in Metrology was set up in 2023.
- ✓ Difficulty in maintaining skilled experts → A challenge to training
- \checkmark Alternative **funding** is sought after the MEDEA project (2025~).

- In June, a new President, Dr Faridah Hussain, was appointed by NMIM, Malaysia.
